



SWCA British Open Wheelchair Championship 2019

Hamilton Ice Rink 10th – 12th February

- (a) The Championship shall be comprised of a Round Robin Competition. The outright winners being the team that tops the League.
- (b) Immediately following the team meeting with the Chief Umpire, a toss shall take place to determine which team shall have the last stone at the first end for the first set of games. In all other games the Hammer has been listed on the Draw Sheet.
- (c) Two points shall be awarded for each win, one point for a draw / peel and no points for a defeat.
- (d) Final ranking in the event of teams being on same points will be firstly be the result in games between them and if that does not provide a final rank then ends scored, shots up and total shots scored shall then count in the event of an overall tie at the completion of the Round Robin
- (e) There will be no Team time outs during the competition.
- (f) All games shall be 8 ends or the bell. A minimum of 5 ends shall be played.
- (g) Due now to Team Germany playing (and playing a game more than the other teams taking part) there will be a blind draw to find the team against whom their score will not count towards their final total (This will remain sealed and unknown to **all** until after the final games have been played !).
- (g) **On Ice Etiquette.** Competitors should always ensure during the competition that On-Ice Etiquette is followed. No foul language, or players moving around in the head or moving up and down the Ice sheet when opposition players are in the process of taking their shot.
